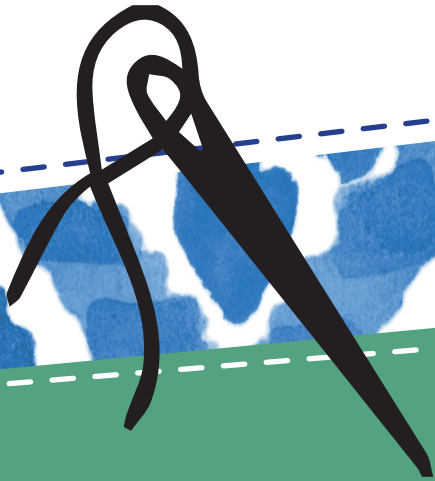


# ETHICAL FASHION
